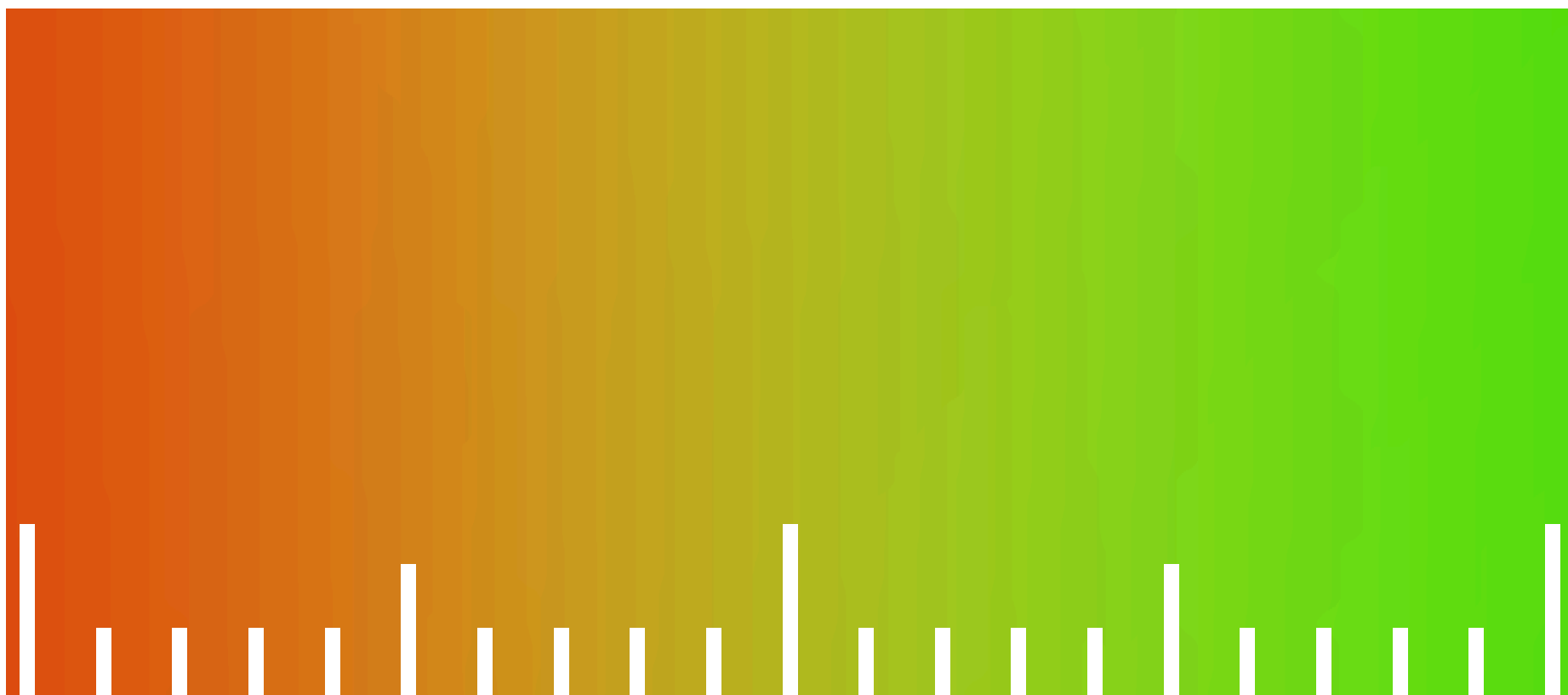

THE VIOLENTOMETER WITH MANAGERS

Fighting violence against sex workers

YOU'RE OKAY TO STAY WHEN...

The situation is okay when your manager:

Respects your limits, your rates, and the contract

Accepts and respects your working conditions

Pays you what they owe you promptly

Is respectful

Provides spaces other than work rooms where
you can take breaks

Makes prevention and hygiene supplies available
(condoms, clean towels and sheets, etc.)

BE ALERT – SAY STOP

There is violence when your manager:

Does not pay you or makes you pay unjustified fees

Offers you more money to perform services you have refused

Takes more than 50% of your income

Makes you work in unsanitary rooms (mold, no window, etc.)

Refuses to let you take breaks

Makes discriminatory remarks (transphobic, sexist, fatphobic, ableist, ageist, etc.)

Does not give you administrative documents that concern you and lies about the steps taken

Offers different rates based on discriminatory criteria

Imposes excessively high rent (above market prices)

PROTECT YOURSELF ASK FOR HELP

You are in danger when your manager:

Humiliates, harasses, threatens or insults you

Monitors and/or controls your messages

Confiscates your phone and/or your documents

Touches you without your consent

Pushes you, slaps you, pulls you, shakes you, hits you

Takes and/or shares intimate images of you without
your consent

Forces you into non-consensual sexual acts

Threatens you with a weapon
