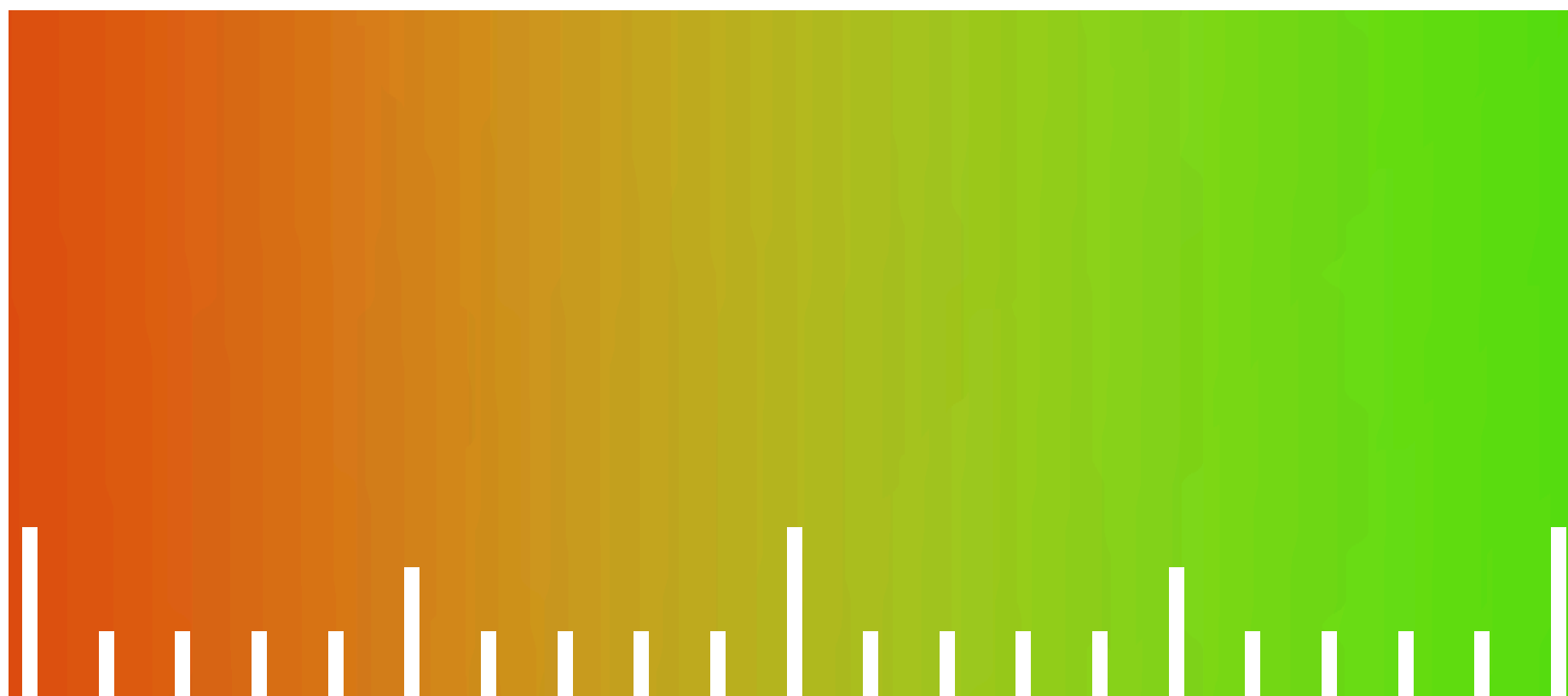

Fighting violence against sex workers

YOU'RE OKAY TO STAY WHEN...

The situation is okay when your partner:

Accepts your work

Makes sure you consent to everything you do together

Accepts your social circle

Respects your tastes and desires

Is happy when you feel fulfilled

Respects your choices

BE ALERT – SAY STOP

There is violence when your partner:

Belittles your opinions and projects

Makes fun of you

Is jealous and possessive

Controls your spending

Controls your outings and your appearance

Checks your phone, private or
work-related

Interferes in your work

Dictates the use of prevention methods within the
couple (use or non-use of condoms, PrEP, etc.)

Questions or undermines your word

PROTECT YOURSELF ASK FOR HELP

You are in danger when your partner:

Threatens to reveal your work activity

Threatens to turn your children against you
or take them away from you

Blackmails you if you refuse to do something

Considers you to be at their sexual service

Forces you to have sexual relations

Forces you to continue your work or to see clients

Takes all your money

Threatens to share intimate photos of you

Loses control when something displeases them

Threatens to commit suicide because of you

Pushes you, pulls you, slaps you, shakes you, hits you
